Course Title: Spanish II

Lesson Length: 2 weeks on modified block

Topic: Careers in Cullman

Overview

Students will discover local career opportunities, choose a career and design a path to that career.

Objective: Students will use vocabulary related to training, education, jobs and careers.

Students will use familiar and newly acquired vocabulary words and phrases in correct structure using future tense.

Essential Question: What will I do for a living?

Materials, Equipment and Technology Resources: Alabama Success Education and Career Planner (Spanish version), Multimedia Projector, Text book.

Activities:

Getting to know the vocabulary -

- Students will match questions to the answers. - Answers from page 2 (handout needed).
- Students will use Alabama Success Brochure to find local businesses that represent the jobs featured in the brochure.
- Jigsaw Activity - Each group presents a page, presenting new vocabulary and cognates. The group disbands and teaches to other students.

Getting to know the grammar -

- Teacher presents future tense. - Large group, small group, individual practice

Project assignment :

Students will create a presentation of the job or career that they would like to have and present it in the target language. Students must include job description along with education or training that they will use. This will be presented in future tense. The presentation may be presented through multimedia.
